

**Ordinance #172; Amendment to Ordinance #166,
Chapter 9-OFFENSES; Article VII. Offenses against Public Safety
Sec. 9-138. Fireworks, for the Village of Elsie
VILLAGE OF ELSIE**

Section 2. General Prohibition on Ignition, Discharge and Use of Consumer Fireworks:

No person shall ignite, discharge or use fireworks or Chinese Lanterns within the Village of Elsie at any time, except that:

(a) The use of consumer fireworks is permitted the day before, the day of, and the day after a Federal holiday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 12 a.m. or at other times as permitted by Michigan Statute MCL 28.457.

(b) The use of low impact fireworks are permitted year-round.

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance will become effective on September 2, 2019. (Effective date must be not less than 20 days after adoption and after publication as required by law.)
