

**Elsie Council Minutes**  
**July 14, 2020**

President Tom Frink called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

AGENDA: Ondrusek moved, Freeman seconded to accept the agenda with an addition to TREASURER: Special assessment. MOTION CARRIED.

INVOICES: Freeman moved, Witt seconded to approve payment of the bills in the amount of \$69,801.10 MOTION CARRIED.

The Zoning Board met tonight regarding a variance, for a new construction located at 321 N. Second St.

TREASURER: 1. Carroll moved, Witt seconded to approve the June 2020 Treasurer's Report as written. MOTION CARRIED. 2. Tina Ward, Clinton Co. Treasurer, sent a transfer of a parcel to the village, as a special assessment. If the Village wishes to purchase, then they must pay the back taxes, or just sit back and wait to see if it is sold.

POLICE: Freeman moved, Ondrusek seconded to approve the June 2020 Police Report as written. MOTION CARRIED.

MANAGER/DPW REPORT: Freeman moved, Witt seconded to approve the Manager/DPW Report as written. MOTION CARRIED.

COMMITTEE: The Ordinance Committee met and decided that it is important that the whole ordinance book be updated. It had been updated in 1991 by Municode. Action Step: Municode has been contacted regarding what can be done for the Village Ordinance book at this time.

PUBLIC COMMENT: There was no public comment.
