**WHEREAS**, Village may provide police protection, as authorized by MCL 41.801, et seq, and other applicable statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Village's may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council of The Village of Elsie wishes to propose a new millage to be levied for police protection for five (5) years, 2023 through 2028 inclusive, at a millage rate of 3.0 mills.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that:

1. The Village Council of Elsie, Clinton County, Michigan, approves the millage question language attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, and directs the Village Clerk to submit it to the Clinton County Clerk to be placed on the August 2, 2022, election ballot within The Village of Elsie, Duplain Township.

2. The Village Clerk is directed to post and publish notices of registration and notices of election, have ballots prepared and provided in sufficient quantity, and to do all things and provide all supplies necessary for the submission of this question at the election as required by law.

3. The Notice of Election for said election in The Village of Elsie shall include notice of the submission of this question in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit B.

4. The question to be voted on at said election shall be stated in substantially the same form and manner appearing on the foregoing Notice of Election attached as Exhibit B.

5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby rescinded.
